HISTORIC ATTRACTIONS

Fort Dobbs State Historic Site

Living history programs provide a window into the tumultuous French and Indian War in the Backcountry frontier of colonial North Carolina.

Darshana Plantation

Once the largest plantation in Iredell County, it is the oldest surviving inland structure in the State. Tours by special arrangement.

Allison Woods

Three thousand wooded acres featuring original buildings dating to the 18th century plus ornamental gardens.

Downtown Statesville

Architecturally rich and economically vital, this historic district is home to a host of fascinating walking tours including *A Walk Back in Time*, *Haunted Statesville* and *Twilight Cemetery Tour*.

A new timber-framed tasting room opened in 2008 and features the work of local artists plus award-winning wines.



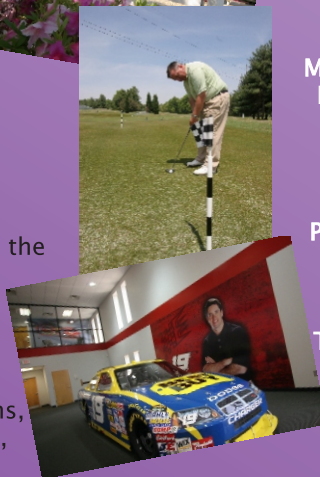
